Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to those parents and carers whose children have return to us after the summer holidays and a very warm welcome to all our new parents and carers. Tapestry

Tapestry is our online journal. Activation emails have been sent to all parents last week, therefore all parents should be able to access and see their children's photos and observations. As parents/carers you can upload photos and observations to the journal so that the staff can see them as it will be a form of communication during the session with your children. If you have any issues logging into tapestry, please speak to the member of staff.

Book Bags

Next week children will come home with their book bags. We would like to encourage all parents to read books with children regularly. Please make a little comment in a book log provided or let your child draw a picture after reding together. Book bags will be sent home on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

September focus

This month children are learning some Preschool rules, such as good table manners, to be kind to all friends and to say please and thank you. Children are practising and learning of self-care by washing hands after going to the toilet and before eating. Children are supported in familiarising themselves with their pegs, trays, lunch bags etc.





Snack

We encourage all the children to bring in a fruit to share with other children during snack time or donation of £2 per week. This may also include a variety of different fruits, breadsticks, crackers, cucumber, and carrots etc...

Healthy packed lunch

Please clearly label your child's lunch box. If your child is staying all day, they will need a packed lunch. To encourage healthy eating, we ask you not to include crisps, chocolates, cakes, or sweets in your child's packed lunch. Please cut grapes and tomatoes lengthways to protect your child from choaking.

Due to extreme allergic reactions, we cannot allow children to bring peanut butter sandwiches or any form of nuts in their packed lunch as we are a <u>NUT FREE Preschool</u>. We would like to thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

Water bottles

All children will need to bring a clearly named bottle of water to preschool each day. We encourage children to have water and not squash in their water bottles.

Sun cream

If we have some warm sunny weather at the start of term, please ensure that you apply sun cream before your child comes to preschool. Please can you also ensure that you provide us with sun cream labelled with your child's name so that we can reapply it if required.

Nappies

If your child is not yet toilet trained, please provide us with both nappies and baby wipes. These need to be in a bag with your child's name clearly labelled on it. If you are in the process of toilet training, please let a member of staff know so that we can support you in this process.

Wellies

We do have an outdoor covered area so that the children can play outside in all seasons. We also have access to the school field for some of the year and the playground at the front of the preschool so please provide your child with wellies so that they are not worried about getting their shoes muddy and can enjoy going in puddles. Once again these can be left at preschool in a named bag.
